14. 1:30 pm Platform presentation by Platform Committee chair. Discussion and adoption.
15. 2:30 pm Resolutions presentation and adoption.
16. 3:15 pm Elections committee results for State Convention Delegates, adoption of results. 2 reps for state Platform Committee.
17. 3:30 pm Adoption of County Delegates as NCRCC members.
18. 3:40 pm State Delegate Certificates passed out. Delegates get white copy.
19. 3:50 pm Comments by NCRCC Chair, Convention Chair. Announcement of April NCRCC meeting.
