Dear Mr. Trump, Gov. Kasich, Senator Rubio and Senator Cruz,

While many of us support or have even endorsed you or one of your colleagues running for president, we write to you without respect to those endorsements. As conservative state legislative leaders, we have a direct understanding of the importance of the States as the laboratories of democracy. By enacting the 10th Amendment and other basic tenets of federalism, our country's founders understood that a too-powerful national government would usurp powers reserved to the States and the American people.

We share serious concerns that the federal government has retreated from the historic partnership of cooperative government between the States and the federal government. It's time to reset the relationship and to promote state-based solutions to our problems rather than "one size fits all" national solutions. That's why we write this letter: to ask the candidates who are asking to run our Nation to agree the following proposals:

- 1. **Restore the balance between the States and federal government.** Return program authority and control to the States, without unnecessary strings, limitations and restrictions. Federal programs like Medicaid, as well as funding through the Department of Transportation and Department of Education, should be block granted to the States to allow state-based solutions and innovation.
- 2. Most States are required to balance their budgets and live within their means. The national debt has reached levels that will significantly reduce the quality of life for future American generations. That's why we must **pass a Balanced Budget Amendment to the U. S. Constitution** that will responsibly require the federal government to live within its means.
- 3. A strong economy is essential for job growth and it allows all Americans to pursue and achieve their God-given potential. While the States have made significant strides at improving local economic conditions through tax reform, we must pass similar tax reform at the federal level to unlock a robust economic recovery for every American at every economic level. Your leadership can help ensure passage of a simpler, broad-based low rate tax code that enhances State reforms and allows every citizen to achieve the American dream.
- 4. Overregulation significantly limits opportunity and economic growth. While everyone agrees that clean air, clean water and safe workplaces are important, commonsense compliance, applied with a cost-benefit balance is essential. Federal regulatory overreach puts Americans out of work, hurting millions of children and families. Congress and the President should pass new regulatory review processes, standards and limitations, including a strong emphasis on cost-benefit balance and common-sense compliance.

5. A strong and stable judiciary that recognizes the essential separation of responsibilities in our federal-state partnership is essential to restore the balance between the States and the federal government. One of the most lasting impacts of any presidency is reflected in the quality and character of federal judges nominated by the President. We ask you to agree to nominate strong Constitutional conservatives who will respect the essential role of state authority in our federal system.

If you are elected President will you join us in advancing policies that are consistent with these five issues to move America forward? We look forward to your reply and we welcome the continuing discussion necessary to set our country on the right path toward Ronald Reagan's "shining city on the hill."
