The Trump-Pence slate of electors was unanimously approved by the Ohio GOP State Central Committee on September 9<sup>th</sup> and it has been disappointing that Chairman Matt Borges cannot support that decision.

This past week Chairman Borges conducted a self-promotional media tour with state and national outlets to criticize our party's nominee. I have no idea what game he was playing. Some Ohio Republicans have described it as disgraceful, I find it utterly bizarre. Enclosed are several news articles you can read and decide for yourself.

I spoke with Mr. Trump on Thursday and he is very disappointed in Matt's duplicity. Mr. Trump told me, "this is why people have lost faith in the establishment and party leaders."
