It has recently been disclosed that Hillary Clinton used a personally-owned Blackberry device exclusively to send and receive all official email correspondence during her tenure as Secretary of State. In addition to the transparency concerns raised by this practice, Secretary Clinton's use of a private device poses serious questions about the security of information exchanged on that device.

Therefore, under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, I request that copies of the following records be provided to me. If your office cannot fulfill any (or portions) of the requests below, please proceed with all requests able to be fulfilled by your office. Upon notification, I will amend or provide additional information pertaining to requests that cannot be fulfilled.

- Any and all documents or communications generated during Hillary Clinton's tenure as
 Secretary of State regarding the configuration, vetting, and/or encryption of Secretary
 Clinton's personal Blackberry and private email server, including such documents and
 communications generated by, but not limited to, the following entities: the State
 Department's IT Configuration Control Board; the Bureau of Information Resource
 Management; the Office of the Chief Information Officer; the Bureau of Intelligence and
 Research; and the Bureau of Diplomatic Security.
- Any and all documents or communications generated during Hillary Clinton's tenure as Secretary of State regarding an exemption from State Department information technology and security regulations or directives for Secretary Clinton's personal Blackberry device and/or her private email server.

In order to determine my status to assess fees, you should know that I am the Research Director and a Deputy Communications Director for the Republican National Committee, and this request is made as part of an information gathering activity and not for commercial use.

I request a waiver of all fees for this request. Disclosure of the requested information to me is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to the public understanding of the operations or activities of the government and is not primarily in my or the Republican National Committee's commercial interest.
