What is the HFA Fellowship?

The HFA Fellowship is an opportunity for people to make history from the ground up by joining the Hillary for America team.

Our mantra is “engage with purpose, organize with heart, and win every day”—and we do it by empowering our volunteers through opportunities like the HFA fellowship.

This eight-week program is designed to test, train, and develop a new class of organizers, and to help the campaign expand our outreach efforts in communities across the country. HFA fellows will learn the basics of organizing and campaign fundamentals so they can empower their communities through grassroots organizing.

Fellows will:

- Get trained in field organizing, messaging, and other activities
- Work alongside grassroots leaders and campaign staff to organize a community
- Talk to supporters and recruit new volunteers
- Register new voters
- Use social networks to help amplify our message (and get out the vote!)
- Build the movement to help elect Democrats this fall

Who is eligible to be a Fellow?

Anyone! This fellowship is for anyone who is committed to working within a community to help elect Hillary Clinton.

What's the time commitment to be a fellow?

The fellowship starts June 11th and ends August 15th. HFA Fellows are asked to make a part-time (10-20 hours/week) or full time (20-40 hours/week) commitment. We'll work with your schedule, whether you're a student, have a job, work from home, or are retired.

Where can I be a Fellow?

You can be a fellow in OH, PA, VA, CO, FL, NC, NV, MI, IA, NH, WI, MN, OR, NM, ME, NE, AZ, GA, WA, CA, NY, and DC.

Do you need any special skills to be a Fellow?

No! We will equip you with everything you need to know to be a successful fellow. We'll have kick-off trainings the weekend of June 11-12th in all states listed above.
